

Show Me Cash Futurity October 22-24, 2021



Futurity Rules

- The Show Me Futurity is open to horses that are 5 years old or younger. Age of the horse is determined as of January 1 of calendar year foaled. Photocopy of registration. All horse are subject to veterinary inspection and management reserves the right to reject any questionable entry. front and back of registration papers or veterinarian's affidavit or year of birth and complete description of unregistered horses must accompany futurity / derby nominations.
- To be eligible for the Show Me Cash Futurity, the horse must never have competed in any barrel race, including AQHA show, playdays, derby, rodeos, etc prior to November 15, 2020. To do so means forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity and futurity tour. Horses may have been entered in other events but not barrel racing.
- The Show Me Futurity will be 2 Go-rounds and an average. Total time of the 2 rounds will determine the Average standing.
- Futurity times can be rolled to the Open 4D.
- You will need to have a current health (for out of state horses) and negative coggins.
- Entry fee will be \$350. Pre entries will close on Monday October 18, 2021 and any entries after that will be added onto the draw and considered late.
- Payback is 80 % of each entry and 100% of the added money.
- \$1,000 guaranteed added to futurity.
- Division of purse is 25% to 1st Go, 25% to 2nd Go, and 50% to Average. A hit barrel in the futurity will be a 5 second penalty since there is an average
- 2D incentive will be figured on a 3/4 second split.
- All futurity horses must be checked-in. **Check-in information will be announced on the facebook page, announced and posted.** Horses must be checked in and NUMBERED to run.
- FUTURITY EXHIBITIONS – All futurity horses MUST BE CHECKED-IN AND NUMBERED to use their 1 futurity exhibition.
- Full dress code is required to compete- hat or helmet, jeans, boots and long sleeve shirt.

- 1st go draw order designates rake brakes and is reversed for 2nd go - rake breaks will not change for the 2nd go.
- Sportsmanship: Show Me Cash Futurity LLC has a no-tolerance policy with respect to animal abuse of any kind at this event. Further, foul language, misconduct, or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff member, or volunteer will result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of any fees. Contestants are responsible for traveling companions and family members.
- Show Me Cash Futurity LLC is not responsible for personal injury, loss, theft or damage. Contestants and all accompanying parties participate at their own risk.
- Any questions or disputes during the Show Me Futurity not covered in rules will be determined by Hannah Kaufman. Show Me Futurity LLC assumes no liability to those who have not read the conditions and having not read these conditions they are still held to their contents.

DERBY/MATURITY RULES

- The Derby/Maturity is open to any horse that is seven years of age and under, as well any horse that has been 100% paid up in a previous Show Me Futurity or Maturity. Age of horse will be determined by calendar year of foaling date.
- A photocopy of the front and back of registration papers of registered horse or veterinarian's affidavit of year of birth and complete physical description of the unregistered horse must accompany nominations. Entry will be considered late if this information does not accompany entry form.
- Horses are not allowed to enter the futurity and the maturity in the same year.
- Derby/Maturity times may be carried over to the Open 4D.
- Entry Fees will be \$200.00 with 80% payback
- 100% payback of added money.
- The 2D will be paid on a 3/4 second split.
- Division of purse is 50 % to 1st Go & 2nd Go, and 50% to Average. A hit barrel in the derby will be a 5 second penalty since there is an average.
- Full dress code is required to compete- hat or helmet, jeans, boots and long sleeve shirt.
- 1st go draw order designates rake brakes and is reversed for 2nd Go -rake breaks will not change for the 2nd go.

- All derby horses must be checked-in. **Check-in information will be announced on the facebook page, announced and posted.** Horses must be checked in and NUMBERED to run.
- Futurity Rules & Regulations will apply to the Derby / Maturity where Show Me Cash Futurity deems necessary.

POLE FUTURITY

- The Show Me Pole Bending Futurity is open to horses that are 5 years old or younger. Age of the horse is determined as of January 1 of calendar year foaled. Photocopy of registration. All horse are subject to veterinary inspection and management reserves the right to reject any questionable entry. front and back of registration papers or veterinarian's affidavit or year of birth and complete description of unregistered horses must accompany futurity nominations.
- To be eligible for the Show Me Cash Pole Futurity, the horse must never have competed in any pole bending competition, including AQHA show, playdays, derby, rodeos, etc prior to November 15, 2020. To do so means forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Horses may have been entered in other events but not pole bending.
 - Entry Fees will be \$75.00
 - Payback is 80 % of each entry and 100% of the added money.
 - A hit pole will result in a plus 5 for the futurity
 - Futurity payout will be a straight payout. - no divisions
 - Any questions or disputes during the Show Me Futurity not covered in rules will be determined by Hannah Kaufman. Show Me Cash Futurity LLC assumes no liability to those who have not read the conditions and having not read these conditions they are still held to their contents.
 - Futurity Rules & Regulations will apply to the Pole Futurity
 - The **Straight 6 Pole Run** (Open Pole Race) will run with the futurity poles but both classes will have separate payouts. A hit pole in the Open Poles will be marked as a no time.
 - Futurity Poles may carry their times over to the open but do not have to.
 - Open Poles will be a \$35 entry fee with 80% payback and will be a 4D full second split

All Around Futurity Horse

The All Around Futurity Horse will be determined by adding the times of the Pole Futurity run and both goes of the Barrel Futurity. The "Average Time" for barrels will not be added in for the all around standings.

Novice Youth

Novice Youth is designed for beginner youth! Contestant must be 14 years or under as of the first day of the Race. Contestant must have never won check in ANY OPEN RACE. They can not have any OPEN LTE!!
